
FCCMC SCHOLARSHIP AWARD 2024

- Purpose: The scholarship has been established, according to FCCMC bylaws, to assist ministers in pursuing degrees in theology/divinity studies.
 Criteria: Applicant must be an active FCCMC member in good standing. Applicant must have been a member of at least two years. Applicant must be a member in good standing of a church. Applicant must be currently enrolled in school pursuing a <u>degree</u> in theology or divinity. (Must be a degreed program, not certifications, nor continuing education).
- **Process:** (Please ensure that application is completed in its entirety). Applicants must submit the following items:
 - 1. Complete application form (please type or print legibly, using black ink).
 - 2. A brief biographical sketch which also includes why you are enrolled in pursuing a theological/divinity degree.
 - 3. An official transcript or School Authentication of GPA and enrollment status (School Authentication section of application).
 - 4. ALL applications must be postmarked by April 19, 2024.
 - Scholarship Award will be presented at the Scholarship Awards Luncheon to be held on Saturday, May 18, 2024, 12:00 p.m. Salem Methodist Church, 2165 Middle Road, Eastover, North Carolina 28312.
